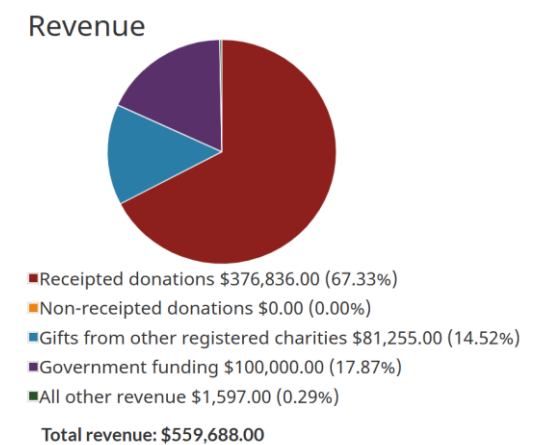

BabyGoRound helps families in need, across the Lower Mainland, to safely care for their babies and toddlers by providing essential baby gear, such as cribs, strollers, diapers, and clothing. They work with a network of approximately 220 health and social service agencies such as the YWCA, domestic violence shelters, hospitals, youth pregnancy programs, and newcomer-serving organizations to identify families who need support.

Once referred, families visit BabyGoRound’s welcoming, store-like facility, where they can “shop” for what they need with dignity and take items home free of charge. Most often, this includes several costly items like a crib, stroller, front carrier, highchair, exersaucer, and breast pump, plus smaller items such as clothing, blankets, toys, feeding and bath items.

Last year, BabyGoRound supported 2,283 families across the region, 72 of whom lived on the North Shore. 15 agencies referred families from North Vancouver, including Lion’s Gate Hospital, Harvest Project, Immigrant Services Society of BC, North Shore Crisis Services Society, North Shore Women’s Centre, and Westcoast Family Centre.

BabyGoRound faces shortages of higher-priced gear, especially cribs and strollers, or items that are still in good shape when they are donated. Some items must be purchased new, for safety reasons, including breast pumps. Our \$10,000 donation would allow them to purchase these much-needed items, ensuring families receives safe, good-quality gear when they need it most.
